
# USDA Trade Mitigation Programs

- \* Received BONUS Offerings from USDA
  - \* 18,244 cases of Fresh Apples and Oranges
  - \* 21 truckloads of canned applesauce, diced pears, and sliced pears (coming March 2020)
  - \* 4 truckloads of pulled pork
  - \* Diverted 1,920,000 pounds to JR Simplot, McCain, Basic American, and Idahoan

## USDA Foods for Breakfast



- \* 2019 Ag Appropriations bill
- \* \$20 million (for entire US)
- \* Annual allocation, one time as of now
- \* Received \$0.01 this year (but it's a start!)



# Annual Processor Reconciliation (aka Sweeps)

- \* Unused Inventory at Processors from 2018-19 SY
  - \* 9,535,619.19 pounds from 106 different raw materials
  - \* \$11,735,508.83 (\$0.05 per meal)
- \* Super Coop estimates unused carryover as of October 31<sup>st</sup>
  - \* 1,920,521.23 pounds
  - \* \$2,566,860.95 (\$0.01 per meal)
- \* CDE has currently swept 805,555.98 pounds

- Open to all processors that submit pricing for all approved USDA Foods End Products and their commercial equivalents
- \* Manufacturer pricing to your distributor
  - \* Bracket pricing based on load size
- \* Does not provide pricing for direct shipment to schools
- \* Mid-year amendment for new items

- \* Return on/about March 1, 2020
- \* No general commercial pricing




# Brown Box – By the Numbers






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

### Chicken Diversions

- \* Divert the amount of pounds that you know you will use
  - Ensure that you use all pounds at all chicken processors before requesting additional amounts
- Chicken Diversions are based off initial requests additional trucks will not be ordered
- \* Individual banks monthly review of usage to remove excess pounds and reallocate to other members

### **Entitlement Redistribution**



- \* January 31
  - \* Possible redistribution of monies for schools not utilizing at least 60% of available processing dollars
  - \* Additional redistribution on March 30 to minimize carryover amounts
- \* Spend your DoD Produce by April 30
  - \* State sweeps May 1
- \* DON'T PANIC JUST..... \$pend \$pend \$pend
